#### **Executive Director's Desk**

The fall season is upon us, a time when we give thanks for the bountiful harvest we enjoy here in Canada. This is a highlight of some of the many newsworthy items I would like to share with you from Administration.

We were very pleased when Le Réseau des services de santé en français and the Champlain LHIN gave approval to our French Language Services Designation Plan which includes the designation of four new services under the French Language Services Act; namely, Complex Continuing Care Therapies, Long-Term Care Therapies, Spiritual Care and Environmental Services. The recommendation is now before the Office of French Language Services of the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care.

We are excited to report that St. Joseph's Continuing Care Centre has been awarded a three-year Accreditation by CARF International. This accreditation award, which is effective April 28, 2015 through to May 31, 2018, is in accordance with CARF Person-Centred Long-Term Care program standards. This accreditation decision represents the highest level of accreditation that can be awarded to an organization and demonstrates our substantial conformance to the CARF standards. In July we underwent the Resident Quality Inspection (RQI) process in which a team of 4 inspectors from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care spent 10 days reviewing our programme delivery in accordance with standards contained in the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 and/or Ontario Regulation 79/10. It should be noted that there are over 500 sections included in both the Act and the Regulation. We are pleased to report that we did not receive any Compliance Orders as a result of this inspection; however, we did receive 12 Written Notifications resulting in 6 Voluntary Plans of Correction. Administration is working diligently to address the noted deficiencies.

## **Spiritual Care**


