State-of-the-art hospital beds for rest and recovery

SJCCC's Hotel Dieu Hospital has 58 patients receiving care and/or rehabilitation, at any given time. Each person is unique and the Centre requires beds that meet the different needs of the individual. This Stryker bed offers pressure redistributing properties for wounds, a higher weight capacity to meet different body types and a more sensitive bed alarm system for individuals who are at a higher risk of falling. When rehabilitating, rest is so important. Being able to offer equipment like this means patients will be on their way to recovery and back home, safer and sooner.

Rehabilitation equipment for confidence and mobility

At SJCCC, it's important to offer rehabilitation equipment that can meet a wide range of needs. Each day, therapy staff utilize the 'Nustep' bike throughout the entire Centre for strength training, light exercise and to encourage activity. This important piece of equipment helps mimic the walking motion to keep seniors and rehabilitation patients as active as possible. In order to see more participants daily, the Centre is seeking one additional bike for its therapy program.



Dietary equipment that meets your needs

Did you know that SJCCC's Dietary Team prepares more than 227,600 meals annually? Meal time is one of the most important and popular events of the day. Each season, the Dietary Team revamps their menu to make each meal as special as the next. Because residents and patients have different nutritional needs and requirements, the team must ensure they are able to provide a variety of different culinary options for every meal. Commercial-grade equipment is required to be able to do all the culinary feats required such as slicing, shredding, chopping, grinding, pureeing, mixing and kneading. Providing equipment like this saves time, giving staff the ability to focus on food quality and person-centred options.
