Centre 105 is a drop-in day program. They offer a hot breakfast, a hot drink, as well as a safe space to socialize. Centre 105 began in 2017 and continues to serve the most vulnerable individuals in our community.

Services they offer: Breakfast, coffee, tea, and access to a washer and dryer. Pastoral Counselling. Legal Aid Advice & Information. Public Health Nurse. Literacy Skills. Activity and Games. Referrals to other agencies. Safe space.

Centre 105 is looking for the following donations: Nonperishable snacks, new socks and underwear (men and women), laundry soap, toiletries, cans of coffee and hot chocolate, tea bags, and gently used winter coats.





STAFF HUB SUCCESS

Since embarking on this venture, we have averaged more than 1,500 purchases per month – we are thrilled! The Hub is located on our first floor right next to our Cafe.
