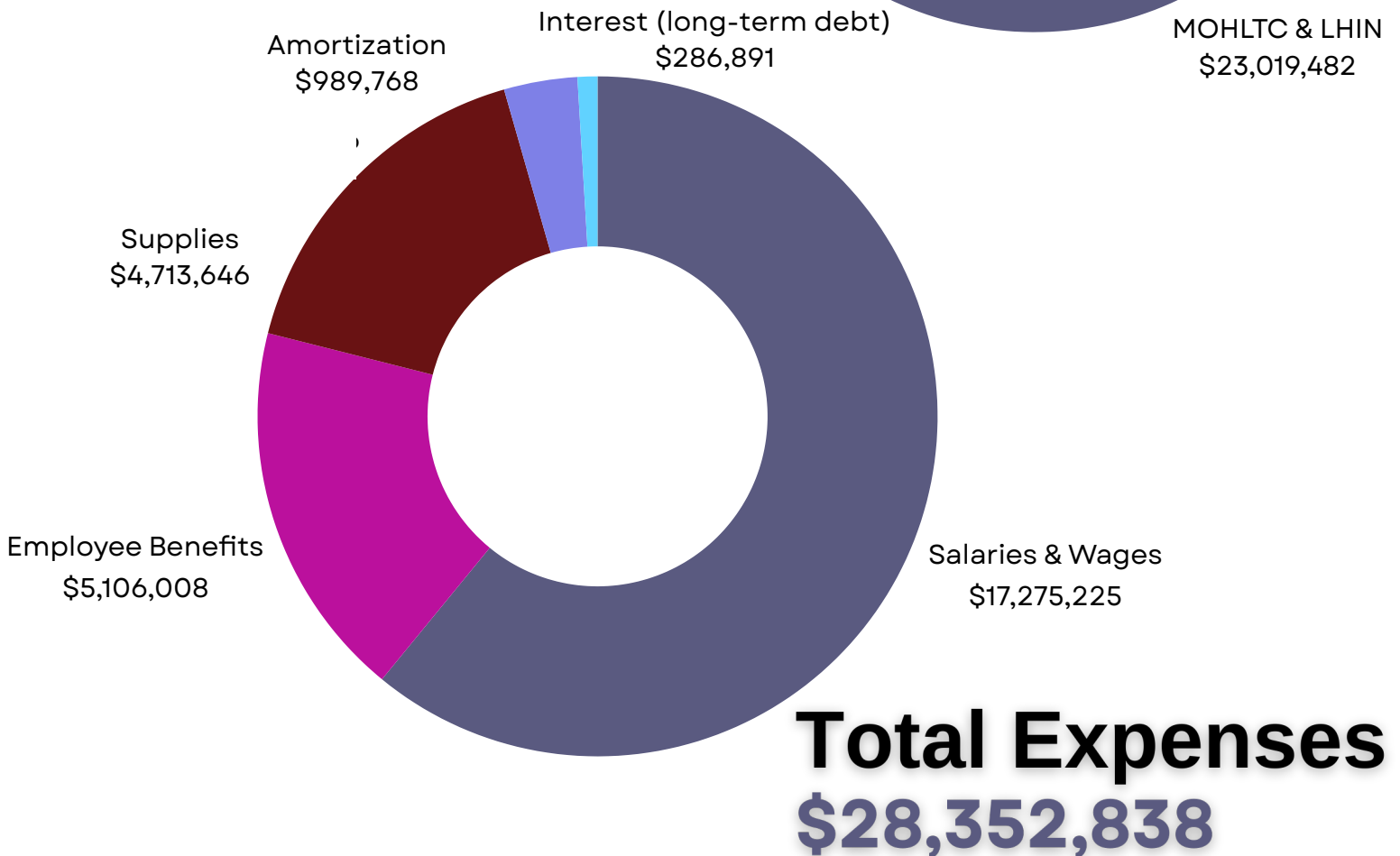
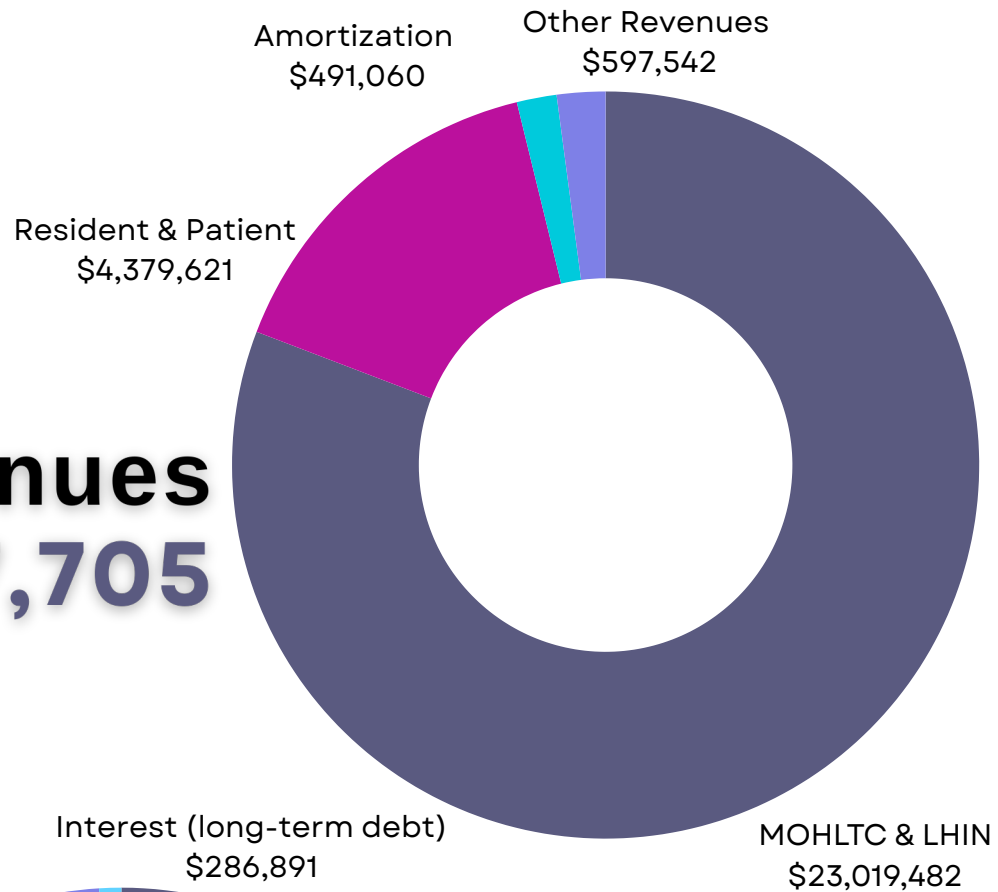

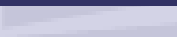

\$28,487,705



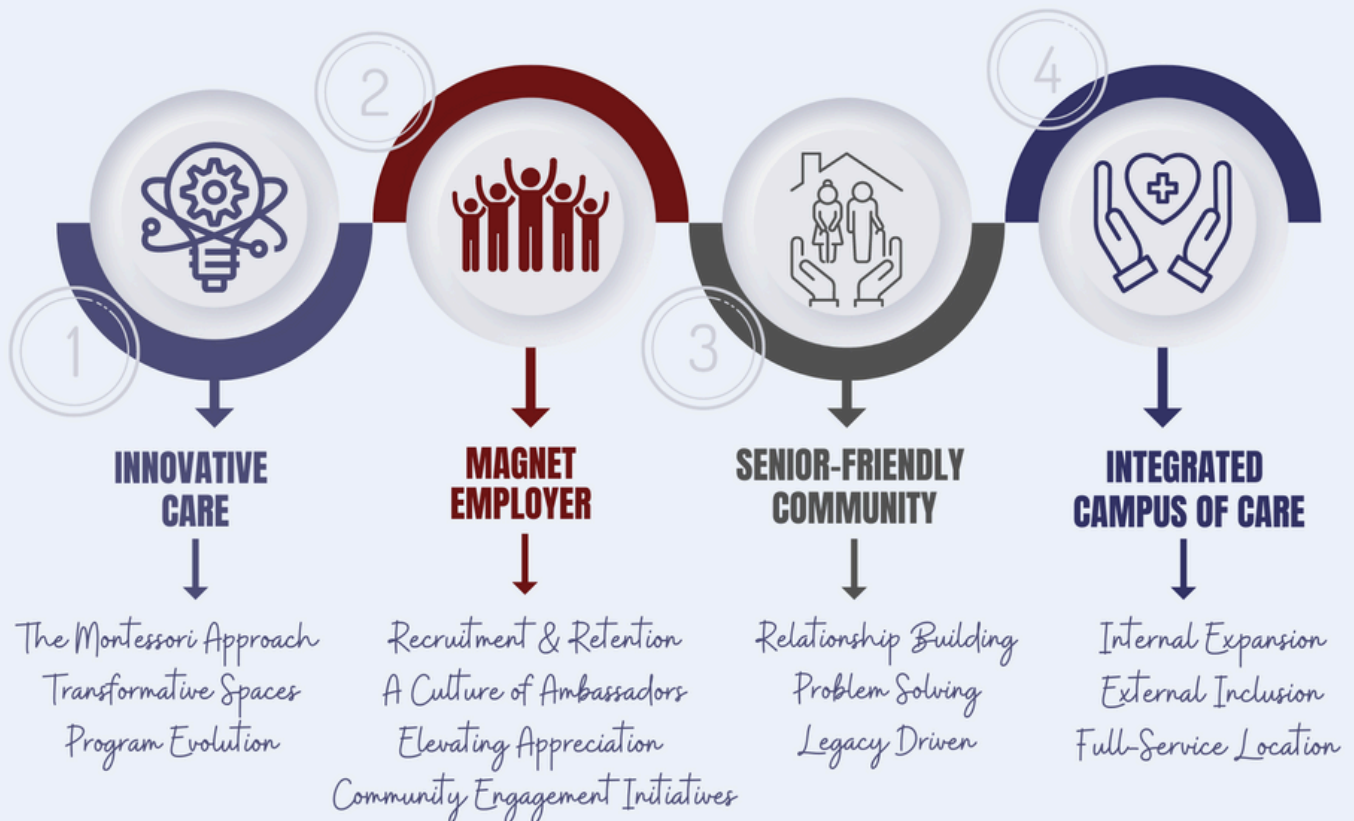


Strategic Plan

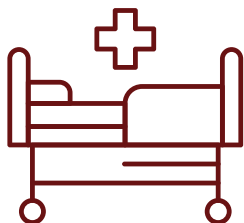

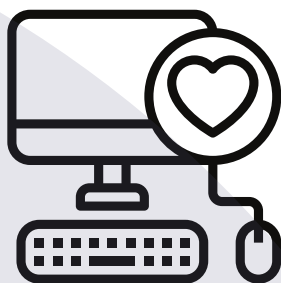
